 - v. Apply for grants to help with education and community service projects
 - b. It is important, as an organization, to follow CDW, use their name "Cowboy Dressage", and have access to the tests, judges' sheets, etc.
 - c. Support the local clinicians what would that look like?
 - i. Help with taking entries
 - ii. Advertising, flyers, posting on FB, and Colorado & National calendars

 - iv. Food service for participants, volunteers, etc
 - v. Help with awards
 - vi. Reimburse organization 1/10 of proceeds or what is equitable per gathering/event

- a. Suggestions from CDW and members:
 - i. Fewer/more outside clinicians and principles
 - 1. enough for professionals to advance
 - ii. More local clinics
 - iii. Fewer/more shows
 - 1. perhaps even a recognized show
 - iv. Focus on and support Colorado clinicians
- b. Working on schedule for 2018:
 - i. Would like to have a points and award system for shows
 - ii. Encourage participation
 - iii. Relook at possible awards
 - 1. ribbons/levels for shows
 - a. Encourages riders to continue to grow and excel
 - b. Every exhibitor receives a ribbon for each ride.
 - c. The color of the ribbon is based upon the score earned on the test, as follows:
 - i. Scores ≤ 53.99 = GREEN
 - ii. Scores between 54-62.99 = WHITE
 - iii. Scores between 63-71.99 = RED
 - iv. Scores between 72-79.99 = BLUE
 - v. Scores ≥ 80 = PURPLE
